## Student Renewals

Students are reminded that student memberships expire annually on September 15 and need be renewed. The renewal portal will be open by Monday, August 22, 2017 for students to renew their registration in the member area of the PEI College of Pharmacists website. Students are reminded that the College also requires the following upon renewal: proof of continued enrollment in a pharmacy program/pharmacy technician program, up-to-date liability insurance (only if the current insurance has expired) and a preceptor/site approval form completed for the most current structured or unstructured practice experience.. Both the insurance and proof of enrollment may be uploaded using the document upload function in the member profile and the preceptor/site approval form is completed online, also through the member portal. Students are only required to renew their registration if and when they are completing structured or unstructured time service in PEI

## CCAPP Pharmacy Technician Graduates—Before 2014

The deadline for registration as a pharmacy technician with the PEI College of Pharmacists for those graduates of CCAPP accredited program prior to 2014 is September 22, 2017. Graduates prior to 2014 were granted additional time to register with the College since the College was not in a position to accept applications prior to enabling legislation that came into effect on September 22, 2014.
