Reporting Requirements for MAiD

As reported in the Island Capsule Edition 4, Volume 21, Health Canada's new federal reporting requirements for medical assistance in dying (MAiD) became effective November 1, 2018. Pharmacists who have dispensed a substance in connection with the provision of MAiD are now required to report to Health Canada within 30 days after the day of dispensing.
