Registration Renewal Reminder

The PEI College of Pharmacists would like to remind members that changes to the renewal deadlines will be in effect for the 2016/2017



registration renewal year. Pharmacy permit holders, pharmacists and pharmacy technicians will be required to have their registration renewals completed through the member portal and any required documentation and fees submitted to the College office by March 15. Late registration penalties of \$250.00 will be applied thereafter. **Any member, not on a leave, who does not submit their**

registration renewal by April 1 will be considered a new applicant and will be required to complete the initial application process for licensure.
