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Extended Practice Certificate Renewal Reminder

The PEI College of Pharmacists would like to remind members that extended practice certificates (EPC) expire annually on March 31. Members who are continuing to practice either drug administration or minor ailment prescribing must log into their member profile and select the Renew EPC button by March 31, 2016. Renewal fees are only applicable to the Drug

Administration EPC (\$25) and not the Minor Ailment EPC. Payments must also be received in the College office by March 31, 2016.

Please note: There are different applications for renewing an EPC and applying for an initial EPC. Please ensure that the correct application is selected in the member profile as the invoice generated will not be accurate.
