## Pharmacy Student Registration

Students are reminded that they must be registered as a student with the PEI College of Pharmacists prior to beginning any structured or unstructured practice experience in PEI. One of the registration requirements is a preceptor/site approval form. Preceptors and sites must be approved prior to beginning practice experience. The application for student registration can be found on the PEI College of Pharmacists website under the licensing tab. Once a student submits an application, they can log into the member area of the website to access the preceptor/site approval form. **Please note that any students that were registered prior to April 1, 2016 will have their registrations extended to September 15, 2016. You will not be required to renew until then.**
