The PEI College of Pharmacists released a [guidance document](#) for pharmacists and technicians in delivering Medical Assistance in Dying in June 2016. The document provided preliminary guidance prior to [Bill C-14](#) coming into force in Canada on June 17, 2016. The College has been working on an updated document over the summer, taking into account the provisions in Bill C-14. A draft document was presented to Council in July and subsequently the draft was approved for consultation at the September 20, 2016 meeting. The College is interested in any feedback from stakeholders. Feedback and comments will be received until 4:00 pm, October 24, 2016
