Deadline for Winter Semester at Selkirk College Approaching

The deadline for application for the winter semester at Selkirk College is quickly approaching. Applications for the National Pharmacy Technician Bridging Program must be received by Selkirk College by December 15, 2016 at 4:00 pm (PST). Winter semester courses for the National Pharmacy Technician Bridging Program begin January 9, 2017. Individuals currently working as pharmacy assistants who wish to register as a pharmacy technician by the December 31, 2018 deadline are encouraged to begin the bridging process as soon as possible. Those who have begun the bridging programs and have not yet submitted an [Intent to Register application](#) (aka: technician candidate application) with the PEI College of Pharmacists are asked to do so right away. Knowing who is working through the process is important information for the College to have for planning purposes.
