## Providing Exempted Codeine Products

[The PEI Pharmacy Act General Regulations](#) sets out provisions for pharmacists supplying exempted codeine products to patients under section 7. Pharmacists are reminded that they are not permitted to dispense exempted codeine products in quantities greater than those described in section 7 (see side bar) without a prescription from a prescriber.

**No person shall sell or supply to another person at any one time, without a prescription, more than**

**(a) 100 dosage units of an exempted codeine product in solid dosage form; or**

**(b) 100 ml of an exempted codeine product in liquid dosage form.**
