Professional Development Log and Renewal

CE Carry Over

The PEI College of Pharmacists extended the CE year for 2015 to end on February 28, 2016 instead of December 31, 2015. The change was made to align the CE year with the renewal year since completing continuing education is a requirement for renewal of registration for pharmacists and technicians. Recognizing that many pharmacists and technicians completed their continuing education requirements prior to the announcement of the CE year change, the PEI College of Pharmacists will allow members to carry over CEUs that they have completed from January 1, 2016 to February 28, 2016 to the new CE year which will begin on March 1, 2016.
