CE Requirement Deadline-Reminder

The PEI College of Pharmacists would like to remind pharmacists and technicians that the deadline for completing their CE requirements for renewal is February 28, 2016. Please ensure that your online Professional Development Log is complete by the deadline. Also, the PEI College of Pharmacists will allow members to carry over CEUs that they have completed from January 1, 2016 to February 28, 2016 to the new CE year which will begin on March 1, 2016. Resigning from the College Register

There are a number of circumstances where a member may wish to consider resigning from the College Register. Examples include retirement, parental leave or if you are relocating outside the province. If you resign from the register:

- You are not permitted to practice pharmacy in PEI
- You are not permitted to use the protected titles as outlined in the Practice of Pharmacists and Pharmacy Technicians Regulations
- You are not required to pay the registration renewal fee or hold professional liability insurance
- You are not required to complete continuing education requirements

Pharmacists and pharmacy technicians who wish to resign from the register will log into their member profile and complete the application for Extended Leave and indicate the effective date and the expected return date. Should a member wish to be reinstated on the PEI College of Pharmacists register, they will need to contact the College office for direction.
