Extended Practice Certificate Renewal Deadline

The PEI College of Pharmacists would like to remind pharmacists that the renewal deadline for Extended Practice Certificates (EPC) is March 31, 2017. EPC renewal must be completed in the member profile by selecting **Extended Practice Certificate-Renewal**. There is a \$25.00 renewal fee for Drug Administration and Dispensing Methadone and Suboxone. There is no renewal fee for Prescribing for Minor Ailments however, the renewal process needs to be completed.
