## Student Unstructured Practice Experience

Summer is upon us and pharmacy students are returning home to begin their unstructured practice experience. Pharmacy students must complete 280 hours of unstructured practice experience in a direct patient care setting and under the supervision of a preceptor as a requirement for registration as a pharmacist.

Students are reminded that they must be registered as a student while completing any unstructured practice experience in PEI and have a preceptor/site approval form completed and approved by the PEI College of Pharmacist prior to beginning practice experience.

At the end of a period of unstructured practice experience, students must log their time by submitting the Unstructured Time Service Form, located in the member area of the PEICP website.
