This survey received the highest response rate for any survey the College has sent out and we appreciate the feedback. As a result of the feedback the College received, there will be some changes to the newsletter in the coming weeks.

Professional Liability Insurance-Reminder

The College would like to remind members practicing direct patient care (Pharmacists in the Part A Register, Pharmacy Technicians, students and interns) that they are required to hold personal professional liability insurance in accordance with section 21 of the *Pharmacists and Pharmacy Technician Profession Regulations*.

Members may notify the College of their updated policies by uploading a copy of their policy in the member area of the College website. Once the document is uploaded, the office receives an email notification that will prompt staff to verify the upload and change the expiry date of the policy in the member profile. Members who purchase professional liability insurance through the PEI Pharmacists Association (PEIPA) are not required to notify the College when a policy is updated as the College has an agreement with the PEIPA to forward this information. Each member's insurance expiry is available on the home page of the member profile.
