

Provisional Pharmacist Registration Pathway

Pathway 1

Applies to: CCAPP graduate/ACPE graduate first professional PharmD programs

Register as provisional pharmacist and practice under a preceptor while completing remaining requirements (waiting for PEBC results)

Pharm D: 175 hours of post graduate experience

BScPharm: 280 hours of post graduate

experience

If unsucessful at PEBC, remain provisional under supervision until successful at Part I and II (up to 2 years)

Pathway 2

Applies to: IPGs who have passed qualifying exam Part I and Part II on first attempt

Completion of DTLM modules
Direct entry to PACE

Register as a provisional pharmacist to complete PACE

Is unsuccsessful at PACE, must proceed to Pathway 3

Pathway 3

Applies to: IPGs unsuccessfull at first attempt of qualifying exam Part I and/or Part II, or who were unsuccessful at PACE

Completion of DTLM modules

Register as a provisional pharmacist to complete practice experience under supervision of a preceptor-280 hours minimum

Evaluation with the preceptor, must meet minimum evaluation outcomes to proceed to PACE

IPG: International Trained Pharmacist; PACE: Practice Assessment of Competence at Entry to Practice; DTLM: NAPRA Diagnostic Tool and Learning Modules
